I know you only have six months to live with your terminal prognosis, but look at life this way...



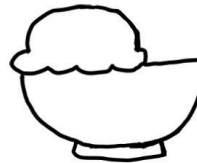
What I want is different. I want death with dignity.

Death hurts people.

Even the Hemlock Society, now called Compassion and Choices, was lamenting the death of a volunteer. Why speed up death?
