





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What I want is different. I want death with dignity.

Remember, once you travel down the road of Physician Assisted Suicide, there is no return -- for the individual or society.






I know you only have six months to live with your terminal prognosis, but look at life this way ...



If you have an ice cream sundae, wouldn't you finish the last half scoop of ice cream even though the sauce and Whipped cream are gone?








Even the Hemlock Society, now called Compassion and Choices, was lamenting the death of a volunteer. Why speed up death?















Compassion and Choices is lobbying for Physician Assisted Suicide in Maryland.
